

## **Lab Facilities**

Wavoo Wajeetha Women’s College wants all its students to be conversant with modern learning aids. To meet the technological demands of the students, the

college has 3 computer laboratories with internet facilities for students. The labs are also equipped with teaching aids such as LCD projectors, scanners and printers. The lab comprises 90 computers for students to work & learn at a time. The entire labs are air-conditioned. Physics and Chemistry laboratories with latest apparatus have also been setup to cater the science students.

### **Transport**

80% Physics with 77% and Economics with 46%. The overall pass presenting of PG is 92%& UG with 87%.

### **Scholarship and Financial Assistance**

We assist our students in getting Government Scholarships every year. This year 74 students availed Minority Scholarship, 133 students availed SC Scholarship and 56 students availed Uzhavar Scholarship. Merit Scholarship by our Wavoo SAR Educational Trust is awarded to economically backward and meritorious students.
