### **Annual Report for the Academic Year 2022– 2023**

Conscious of the hand of God in all our achievements and the joy of having risen to the challenges of the past year successfully, I am here to present to you a brief report of the landmarks of our progress during the academic year 2022-2023

#### **History**

Begun Sixteen years ago with the desire to serve the young women in the locality, Wavoo Wajeeha Women's College has grown in strength and is grounded in its conviction that a women's greatest asset is her education. Consequently all activities of our college are geared towards the total liberation and development of the whole person of its beneficiaries. With excellence as its target, quality as its policy and service to the marginalized as its mission, the college is dedicated to the empowerment of women through quality education and the uplift of the underprivileged with monetary and psychological support.

Education is the key for women to achieve economic independence. Although women in the majority of countries have the right to get education, equal access to education for women still remains a problem.

For the women who are struggling to access education, and for those who want to end educational inequality, WavooWajeeha Women's College emerged as a diamond to the students of this locality.

At this point I must honor our Founder President Alhaj Wavoo S. Seyed Abdur Rahman who emerged as a man of the masses and the voice of the voiceless. His cascading spirit holds intelligence promises and hopes to women's education.

What was planted as a sapling in the year 2006 with the strength of 124 students and 12 staff now grown out as a banyan tree with the strength of 1,198 students and 71 teaching and 47 non-teaching staff members in March 2023. As a Principal of this college, I'm proud to state that so far 4396 students were graduated from this institution till date. Our students take equal part in the quality journey and their enthusiastic participation in academic ventures.

## **Programme of study**

The College continues its 9 Under graduate programmes. B.A Tamil, B.A English, B.A Economics, B.Com, B.Sc Mathematics, B.Sc Computer Science, B.Sc Information Technology, B.Sc Physics & 4 PG programs. M.A English, M.Com, M.Sc Mathematics, M.A. Tamil Literature & a Diploma course in Islamic Theology in addition.

## **Library**

“A library is a good place to go when you feel unhappy, for there, in a book, you may find encouragement and comfort. A library is a good place to go when you feel bewildered or undecided, for there, in a book, you may have your question answered” – E.B.White.

In our college, we have a library which houses around 9749 books on different disciplines and branches. We have subscribed 14 journals of academic importance, 17 magazines of different categories and 7 newspapers in various languages. These rich resources benefit a lot in quenching the thirst for knowledge of both our students and staff. With the agenda of uplifting the scope of research and to provide the students and staff members access to various online research publications, our library has subscribed **N-LIST**( National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content).

On 27/02/2023 our Library Committee organized an Elocution Competition on the topic “Fabulous 2022” for the students. This theme was selected as an attempt to rewind the year 2022 and throw some optimistic light on it. Students enthusiastically participated in the event and shared their own views and perspectives about the bygone year.

Every semester Library Committee meeting is organized by the library to discuss the proceedings of library. This year a few resolutions were passed in the Library Committee meeting regarding the Readers’ Forum. To highlight, it was decided to publish the extraordinary book reviews written by our students, in the college magazine.

## **Lab Facilities**

Our College has well-equipped computer labs to meet the academic demands of the Department of Computer Science, Information Technology, Commerce and Business Administration. We have around 119 computers with Intel dual core systems and high speed Lan. We have Wi-Fi enabled Campus with fiber optic internet which is accessible from the server round the clock. We have well equipped Physics Lab and Chemistry Lab for the Physics Department.

## Transport

The college has **16** buses which are made available to the students and the faculty members for commuting from various points. This facility has made it possible to start the classes on time and thereby helping the academic process.

## Prayer Hall

Our college has three 'Prayer Rooms'. One on the ground floor and others on first and second floors. Each room is fully facilitated with prayer mats and Holy Quran for recitation. The Prayer room is open for daily prayers for students and staff members.

## Academic Excellence

True to the proverb '*You reap as you sow*', the efforts of the students and staff members have been rewarded with good results in their academics.

I am happy to state that the Departments of, B.Sc Computer Science, B.Com, B.A.Economics, B.A.Tamil,M.A English Literature, M.Com, and M.Sc Mathematics and M.A.Tamil have secured centum results for 2019-2022 batch .(**Annexure – I**).

Diploma in Islamic Theology affiliated to M.S. University was introduced in the academic year 2016-2017 and it was greatly welcomed by the students and parents.216 students received their diplomas and 60 of our students are going to appear for the University exam on August 2023.

We appreciate 8 staff members from the Depts. of Arabic, Mathematics, Computer Science, Information Technology and Physics for securing Centum results in the recently published November 2022 Examination results. Details are given below.

### **Scholarship and Financial Assistance**

We assist our students in getting Government Scholarships every year. In the previous academic year 2021–2022, 131 students received a minority scholarship worth Rs. 6,60,133/- and 363 students applied for it this year (2022-2023)

In 2021-2022, 117 students availed SC Scholarship worth Rs.3,33,250/- and 121 Students have applied for it in 2022-2023 academic year.

In 2021–2022, 15 students received sum of Rs. 39,750 under Uzhavar Scholarship, and 12 students have applied for it this year.

Scholarship by our Wavoo SAR Educational Trust is awarded to economically backward students. Scholarship amounting Rs. 2.76 Lakhs in 2021-2022 and Rs.2.52 Lakhs in 2022-2023 granted and their generosity goes even beyond this.

Merit Scholarship is given to outstanding performers by our Wavoo SAR Educational Trust. Scholarship amounting Rs. 65,000/- is granted in 2022-2023. Also, they offered scholarships for Rs. 60,000 and Rs. 70,000 for the wards of teaching and non-teaching personnel in 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 respectively.

Our students received Rs. 50,000 from the Doctor's Association in 2021–2022 and Rs. 40,000 from it in 2022–2023. We sincerely appreciate Secretary Sir for taking the initiative.

We received a total of Rs 7.92 Lakhs in 2021-2022 and Rs. 2.40 Lakhs in the academic year 2022-2023 from Cassim Trust, Udangudi.

Our students received financial assistance from numerous trusts, including IQRA (Kayalpatnam), India Zakat (Association of Muslim Professionals), and the Fewa Trust (Chennai).

At this Juncture, We are pleased to inform you all that Wavoo Wajeeha Women's College has been chosen for the Central Govt Scheme called 'Samarth', which is run by Ministry of Textiles. We proposed to conduct a Aari Work – Skill Oriented course in May 2023 for the rural residents of Kayalpatnam and the surrounding areas.

### **Pudhumai Penn Scheme**

The Government of TamilNadu has launched Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Higher Education Assurance Scheme to enhance the enrolment ratio of girls from Government schools to Higher Education Institutions. It aims to provide financial aid to girl students to pursue their higher education by providing them with a financial aid of Rs.1000 per month till she completes their higher education. The amount will be directly deposited in the bank account of the female student. The scheme not only provides financial help but also focuses on modernization and women's empowerment. This step will surely motivate many girl students to pursue higher education and discourages many evil norms like child marriage prevailing in society. Totally 142 students received Rs.1000/- every month since Sep 2022.

### **Marching towards IQAC**

Our institution's Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been working relentlessly to ensure and enhance the quality of education and overall academic excellence. IQAC has undertaken several initiatives to improve education quality during the academic year 2022-2023. During the year, IQAC conducted nearly 15 meetings with criteria heads, NAAC coordinators, and the principal Madam to discuss various aspects of quality assurance. The objective of the meetings was to ensure that each department maintained the necessary files and documents to support the quality assurance process.

On 16.06.2022, an IQAC meeting was held with management members, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Criterion heads, the NAAC coordinator, and Principal Madam. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the drawbacks and missing information in each criterion and to present the criteria information in the form of a PowerPoint presentation.

IQAC organized **Faculty Development Programme** in 'Innovative Techniques in Research Methodology' on 03.10.2022. Dr. Leena Jenefa, Innovation Ambassador and Associate Professor, Dept of Management Studies, Vel Tech R&D, Chennai. 36 Staff members participated in this programme and gained knowledge in research perspective.

On March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, an IQAC meeting was held in the ICT hall. The meeting was attended Dr. Mrs. V. Rama, the principal of the institution. Dr. A. Syed Mohamed, the IQAC coordinator at Sadakathullah Appa College. Mrs. S.A. Rahmath Aameena Begum, IQAC coordinator, and Dr. Mrs. J. Sugantham Parimala, Assistant IQAC coordinator. All criteria heads from each department also attended the meeting.

On 22.09.2022, a meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was held in the principal's room of the institution. The meeting was attended by the NAAC Coordinator, Assistant Coordinator, and heads of the 4th, 5th, and 6th criteria. The internal audit report of the were discussed . During the meeting, the IQAC members discussed the findings of the internal audit report and identified areas that needed improvement.

On 1st October 2022, an IQAC meeting was held in the ICT Hall at 10.30 am. The meeting was attended by the principal, the IQAC coordinator, and the Asst. IQAC Co-ordinator, the 1st Criteria Head, and members of the committee. During the meeting, the 1st Criteria presentation was discussed by committee members. The presentation was reviewed, and members were asked to collect feedback from alumni. They are asked to include the YouTube link and PPT presentation in the coursework notes

The meeting of the IQAC was held on 1st November 2022 in the principal's room. The participants discussed various issues related to the workload, timetable, and Pending work of the criteria. The following decisions were taken during the meeting: The participants discussed the pending work of the criteria and agreed that it needs to be completed as soon as possible. They decided to allocate specific tasks to each member of the criteria and set deadlines for completion.

Overall, the meeting was productive. The attendees left with a clear understanding of the steps that need to be taken to ensure the successful accreditation of our institution.

### **Earn While Learn**

All India Council for Technical Education and All India Technical and Management Council (AITMC) has announced the launch of **Earn While Learn** scheme in 2017. The scheme supports government of India's vision of developing a strong and sustainable economy by enhancing employable skills among the youth. Our college provides ample opportunity to students to earn and this scheme was implemented in our institution in December 2022.

Totally 31 students are benefitted under this scheme and their skills are used for assisting NAAC and administration works of the departments concerned. Each student is receiving Rs.500 per semester.

### Credit Courses

Credit courses were launched by IQAC in the even semester of 2022–2023. In December 2022, each department offered an add on course of 30 hours to 3 year students and an extra credit course of 15 hours to 2 year students in other disciplines. Beyond what they learned in the classroom, students are learning new things. There are more than 200 students registered in the courses, and those who successfully complete them will earn certificates.

Through this flagship program the students will be able to get trained and ensure they get jobs according to their skill sets. **Mrs.A.Nesa Agnes Bellinta , Head, Dept of Computer Science is appointed as SPOC for this Programme, She is coordinating all the activities associated with this Govt Initiative.**

The Government of Tamil Nadu conducted a Career Guidance Program through Naan Mudhalvan Scheme for all UG and PG final year students from various departments on 19 November 2022, 243 Students attended the session, which featured a beautiful address on "Education Guidance and Career Guidance" from the program's resource person Mr. S. Lingam, M.Sc., Team Expert, Veranda Race, Tirunelveli.

Dr.S.Selvasanthi has attended NSS Orientation Programme in Anna Cemetery Library, Chennai under Nan Mudhalvan Scheme organized by School and Higher Education Department of Tamilnadu on Feb 13, 14,2023. In continuation with this, FDP Were conducted for staff members. Consequently the same mandatory training is being implemented and conducted for our college students. **(Annexure – II).**

### **Internship**

For secure employment with a reputable company, where students can utilize their skills and to look for a challenging career with an MNC and also to seek an entry-level position to begin their career in a high-level professional environment, 4 students from III CS and 4 students from III Year IT got an internship opportunity in ICANIO Technology Labs Private Limited, Tirunelveli. They are involving in the development of their live project during their training period (Jan 2023-June 2023). Students are getting trained in React JS, Python Programming and Testing. **(Annexure – III).**

### **Partnering with ICT Academy**

The institution has made a MOU with ICT Academy, to prepare the students for the industry and bridge the gap between academic knowledge and industry-relevant skills. The Study Webs of Active learning for Young Aspiring Minds–National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (SWAYAM-NPTEL), is an initiative taken by seven Indian Institutes of Technology and Indian Institutes of Science for creating self-paced course contents in various disciplines. It enables education as an easy and available to all learning experience. The programme was inaugurated at our college from March 2020. 2 Students and 6 Staff members from different disciplines enrolled themselves and cleared their examinations and 2 Staff are currently pursuing their courses. ### **Online certification**

We are assisted in becoming job-ready for an in-demand career field by Great Learning Academy and Analytics Vidhya. Students from Dept of Computer Science and Information Technology obtained a career credential, used their knowledge in practical projects that displayed their abilities, and had access to resources for job searching. (Annexure – V)

### **Student Welfare Scheme**

Our college has introduced 'Student Welfare Scheme' which aims at reaching out to the needy students in terms of offering them not only guidance, counseling, moral and academic support, but also extending financial assistance to help the financially disadvantaged fellow students to clear off their fees.

This initiative has been in effect since September, 2022 and through this initiative, the Students have been able to generate Rs. 1, 08, 644/- from Sep, 2022 till Feb, 2023. 27 needy students got benefitted and their fees were paid. This self-supporting system inculcates in our students values of social service, concern for the fellow beings, financial discipline and eventually it results in creating a culture for caring among the students. **(Annexure – VI)**

### **Skill Development Courses**

To create a platform for the student's future and to achieve economic independence, our college has provided skill based activities for the students and access to self-employment opportunities in the forms of Skill Development Courses conducted through **Wajeetha Skill Academy** from 2012 onwards after regular classes.

The courses offered by the academy are Spoken English, Spoken Hindi, DTP, Tally, TNPSC, Handwork, Tailoring, Hand Embroidery, Ari Work, Beautician Course, Motor Driving, Artificial Jewel Making, Yoga, Nutrition, Soft Skill Development, Kitchen Corner and Basic Computer. 20 students got driving license and 4 students are currently attending the class.

### **Parent Teacher Association**

Many departments organized their department Parent-Teacher Association meeting in September 2022. 372 parents in total attended the meeting and discussed about their Ward's attendance, test marks and other details.
