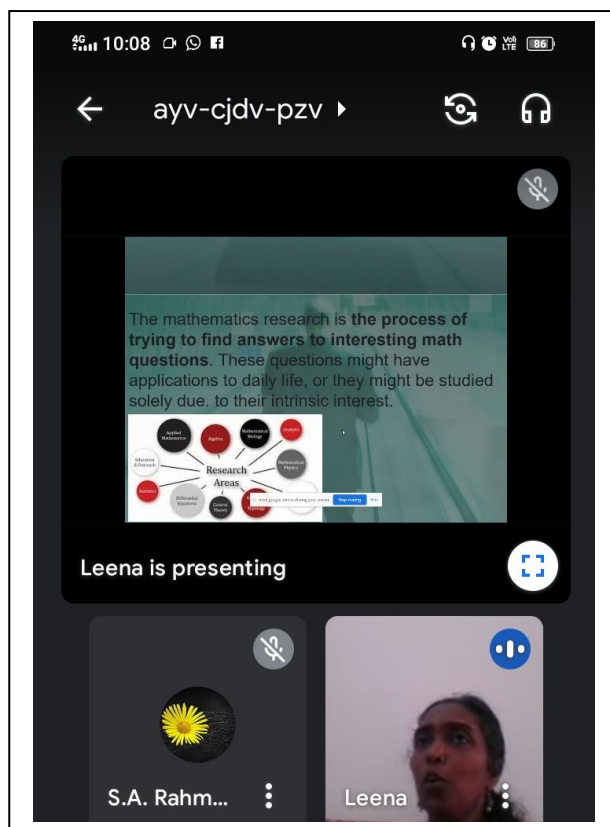
Red Ribbon Club
