





Impact of COVID-19 on People's Livelihood their health and our food systems

The COVID-19 pandemic has led to a dramatic loss of human life worldwide and presents an unprecedented challenge to public health, food systems and the world of work. The economic and social disruption caused by the pandemic is devastating: tens of millions of people are at risk of falling into extreme poverty, while the number of undernourished people, currently estimated at nearly 690 million could increase by up to 132 million by the end of the year.

Millions of enterprises face an existential threat. Nearly half of the world's 3.3 billion global work force are at risk of losing their livelihoods. Without the means to earn an income during lockdowns, many are unable to feed themselves and their families. For most, no income means no food, or, at best, less food and less nutritious food.

Millions of agricultural workers – waged and self-employed – while feeding the world, regularly face high levels of working poverty, malnutrition and poor health, and suffer from a lack of safety and labour protection as well as other types of abuse. With low and irregular incomes and a lack of social support, many of them are spurred to continue working, often in unsafe conditions, thus exposing themselves and their families to additional risks.

COVID -19 PANDEMIC IN INDIA

The COVID-19 Pandemic in India is a part of the worldwide pandemic of corona virus disease 2019 (**COVID-19**) caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome corona virus 2 (**SARS-CoV-2**). As of 22 June 2023, according to Indian Government figures, India has the second-highest number of confirmed cases in the world (**After the United States of America**) with 44,993,543 reported cases of COVID-19 infection and the third-highest number of COVID-19 deaths (after the United States and Brazil) at 531,896 deaths, both directly and indirectly related to COVID-19 to have taken place in India.

The first case of COVID-19 in India was reported on 30 January 2020 in three Indian Medical Students who had returned from Wuhan, the epicenter of the pandemic. Lockdowns were announced in Kerala on 23 March and in the rest of country on 25 March. Infection rates started to drop in September. Daily cases peaked in Mid-September with over 90,000 cases reported per-day, dropping to below 15000 in January 2021. A Second wave beginning in March 2021 was much more devastating than the first, with shortages of vaccines, hospital beds, oxygen cylinders and other medical supplies in parts of the country. By late April, India led the world in new and active cases. On 30 April 2021, it became the first country to report over 400000 new cases in a 24-hour period. Experts stated that the virus may reach an endemic stage in India rather than completely disappear; in late August 2021 Soumya Swaminathan said India may be in some stage of endemicity where the country learns to live with the virus.

India began its vaccination programme on 16 January 2021 with AstraZeneca vaccine (**Covishield**) and the indigenous **Covaxin**. Later Sputnik V and the Moderna Vaccine were approved for emergency use too. On January 30, 2022, India announced that it administered about 1.7 billion doses of vaccines and more than 720 million people were fully vaccinated.

How did the corona virus start?

The first case of COVID-19 was reported December 1, 2019 and the cause was a then new corona virus later named SARS-CoV2, SARS-CoV-2 may have originated in an animal and changed (mutated) so it could cause illness in humans. In past, several infectious disease outbreaks have been traced to viruses originating in birds, pigs, bats and other animals that mutate to become dangerous to humans. Research continues, and more study may reveal how and why the corona virus evolved to cause pandemic disease.
