delivered a speech about “Importance of Physical Activities of Women” and the healthy food for them.





Fig.2: Circular for Yoga





Fig.3: Programme Schedule




Fig.5: Flyer and Circular for World population day




Fig. 9: Bonafide Certificate




Fig.10: Circular for Awareness Meeting




Fig.11: Circular for Tree Plantation Programme
